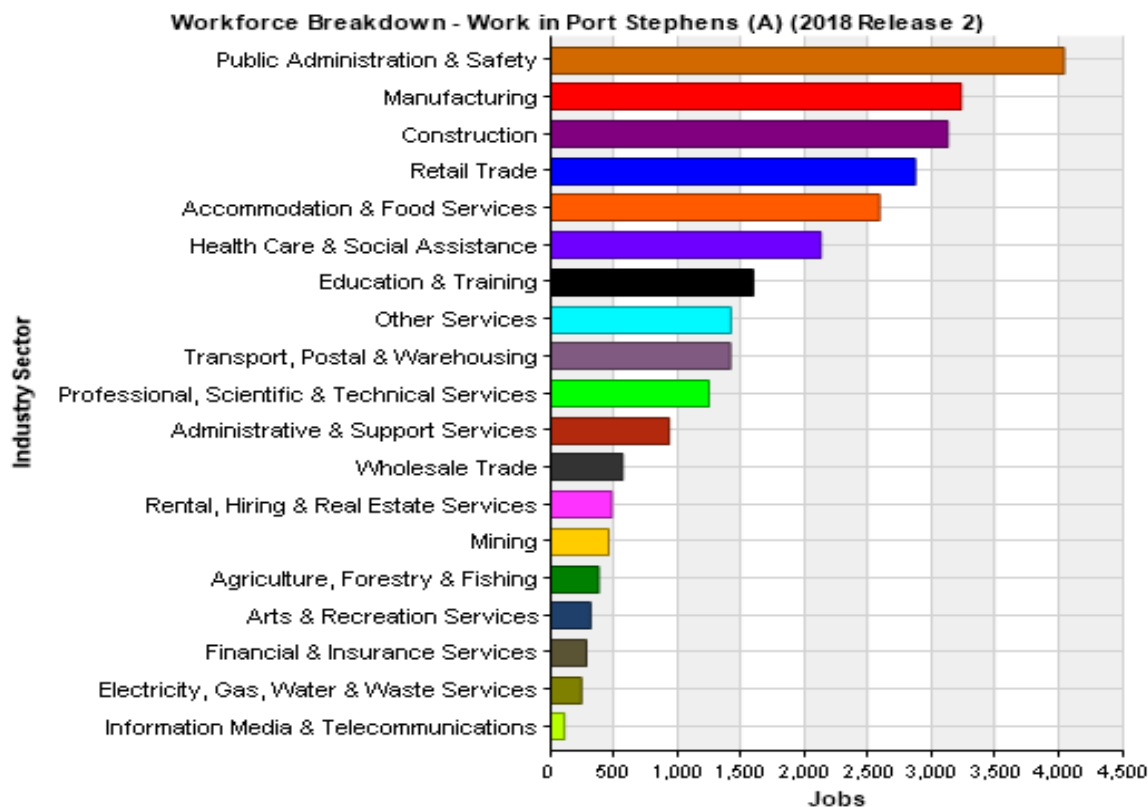


Port Stephens Council Request for Employment Data from Tomaree Business Chamber

Home to 72,695 people, Port Stephens supports **27,346 jobs** and has an annual economic output of **\$11.914 billion**. Below is a breakdown of Port Stephens jobs, by industry sector.



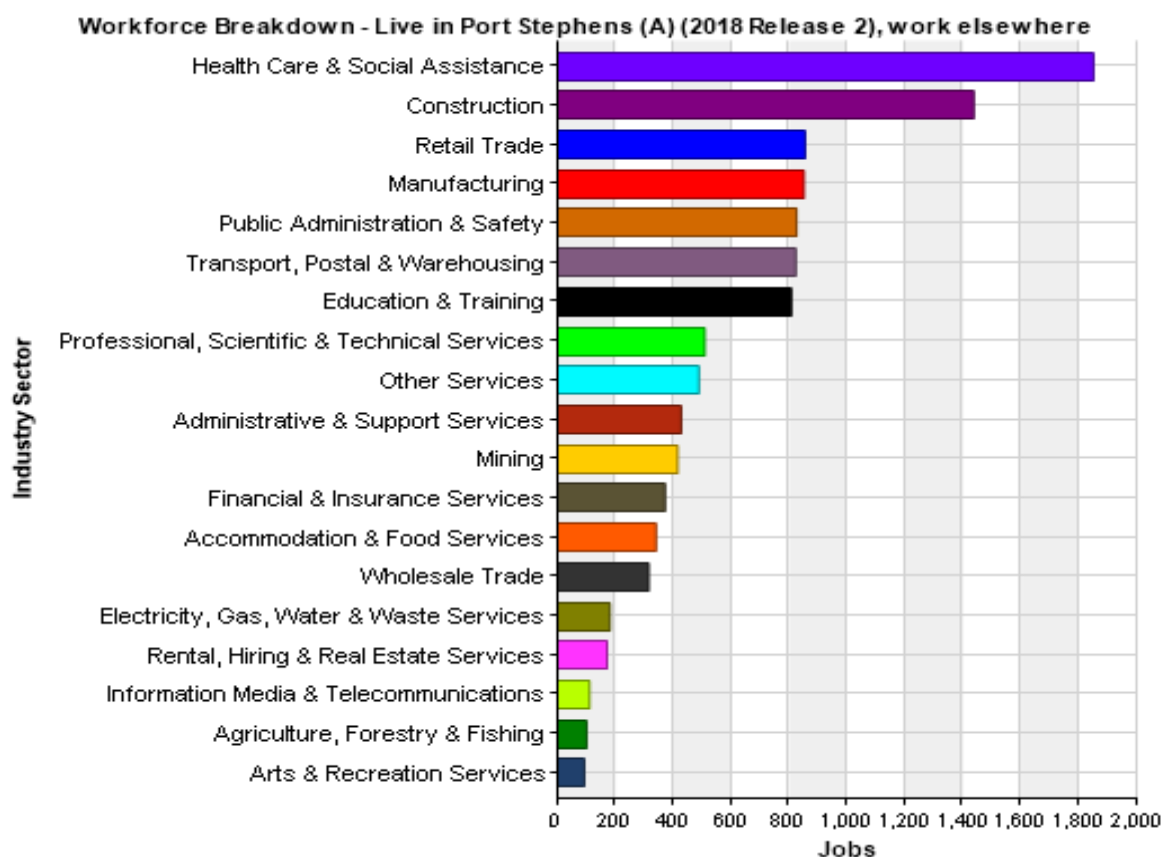
Port Stephens jobs in industries have changed between 2011 and 2016 as below. Please note that this data refers to Port Stephens jobs, not jobs held by residents.

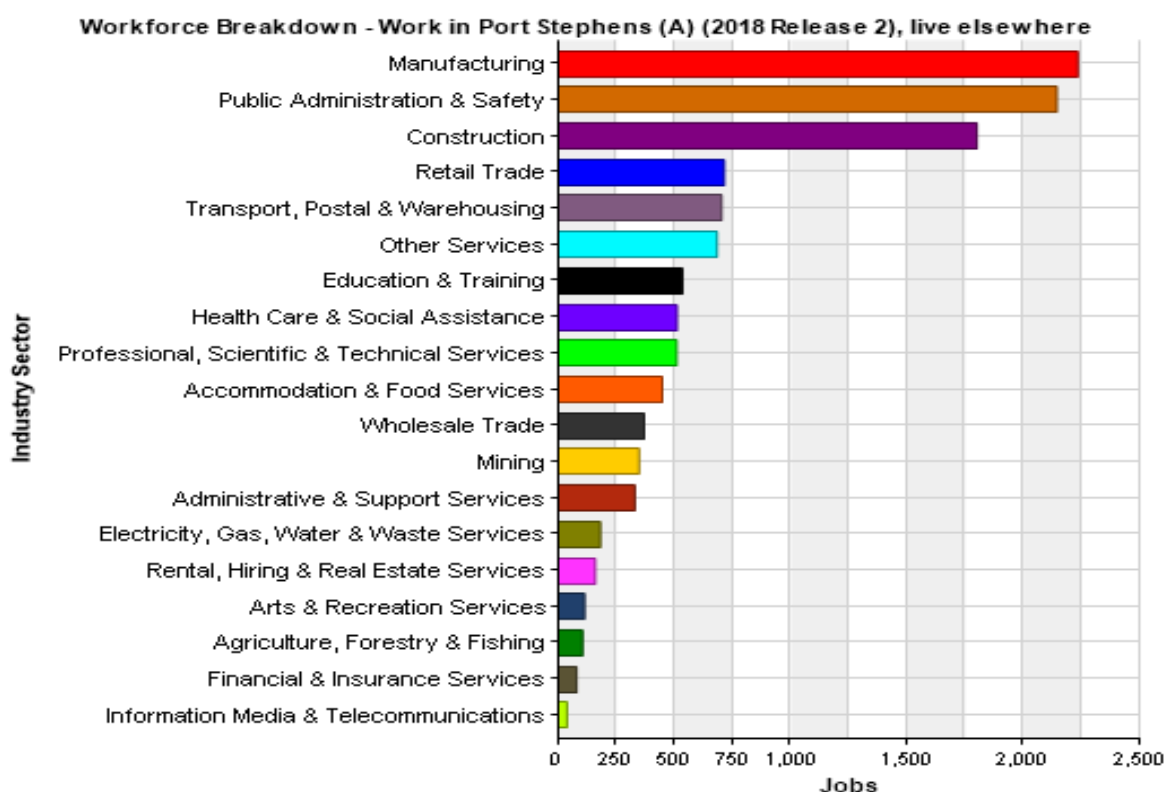
The table below illustrates the **changing numbers of businesses by employment range**.

There are 10,965 employed people who **live in Port Stephens, and work elsewhere**. 5,907 commute to Newcastle, 1,838 to Maitland, 1,245 No Fixed Address (NSW) and 959 commute to Lake Macquarie. (Note that this data can be broken down further if required, for example to indicate where workers in specific sectors are commuting to) (Note that we do not have data for residents who commute for education)



Conversely, there are 11,992 people who **work in Port Stephens and live elsewhere** – 4,404 in Newcastle, 2,963 in Maitland and 2,705 in Lake Macquarie.



Looking specifically at the Tomaree Peninsula, east of Salt Ash and including Tilligerry, the number of resident workers is 12,135, approximately 47% of Port Stephens' workforce.

- 1,546 in Accommodation & Food Services
- 1,402 in Retail Trade
- 1,299 in Construction
- 1,048 in Public Administration & Safety
- 882 in Education & Training
- 625 in Professional, Scientific & Technical Services

- 482 in Manufacturing
- 269 in Rental, Hiring & Real Estate Services

- 2,052 are Technicians & Trade workers
- 1,704 are Professionals
- 1,432 are Clerical & Administrative Workers
- 1,711 are Community & Personal Service Workers
- 1,362 are Labourers
- 1,429 are Managers
- 1,445 are Sales Workers
- 769 are Machinery Operators & Drivers
